**Solution**

We are architects and for the last one and half years we have been living in a 40 m2 apartment, which we designed by and for ourselves. While creating designs for Graham, we made good use of our experience, which could be briefly outlined in 5 rules:

1. Balance of areas. The area of the bedroom is equal to the area of the bed itself, whereas the main space, such as the living room, must be large and spacious.
2. Separation of functions. Admit it, on certain days you don't have enough time to make your bed and clear away your scattered socks. It's cool when you can just leave them behind the closed door and go to the kitchen to have your coffee.
3. Use of height. Do you often use space above 1.9 meters? However, it is also suitable for living and storing things.
