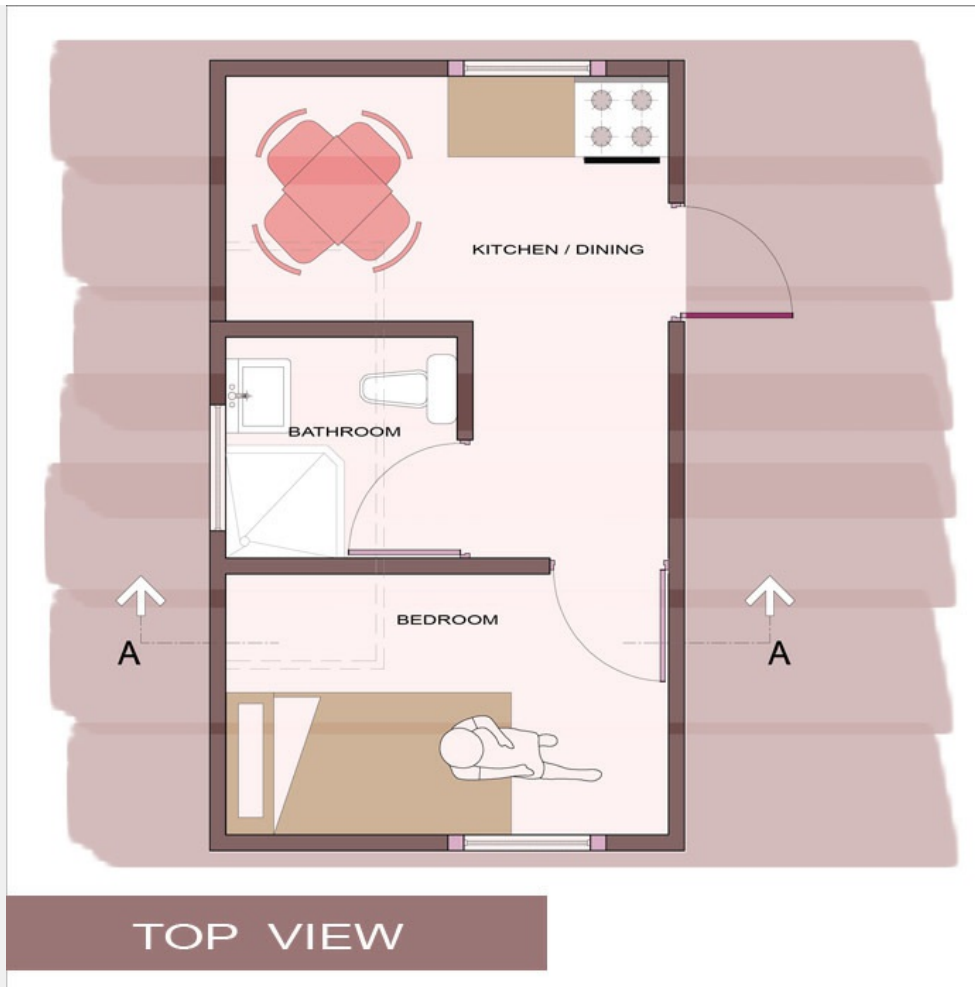


## 1/2 little big box
