Solution

Because the houses can be stacked, there will be land available after implementation. This land can be developed by the government to generate income. A financial impulse for the housing project can be generated in this case. The developer of the available land can do this by providing micro-credit and temporary employment. Therefore, prior to the implementation, contracts must be made to ensure that at least a part of the future generated income will flow to the housing project.
