1 BILLION SLUM DWELLERS

One billion people worldwide live in slums and the figure will likely grow to 2 billion by 2030. Project Ground-Up is targeted at preparing the site for a sanitary living condition, building a basic house for expansion, and building a self-managed and sustainable village cooperative and micro-enterprise that support the building of such houses as a short term goal, and eventually to lift poverty as a long term goal.

INFRASTRUCTURAL IMPROVEMENTS

Sanitation condition in slums are disastrous, dominated the accumulation of waste water and rainwater, which contributed to health hazards for inhabitants. Our goal is to prepare the site so that grey water can go into sewage lines and bathrooms are self-contained compost units that were proven
