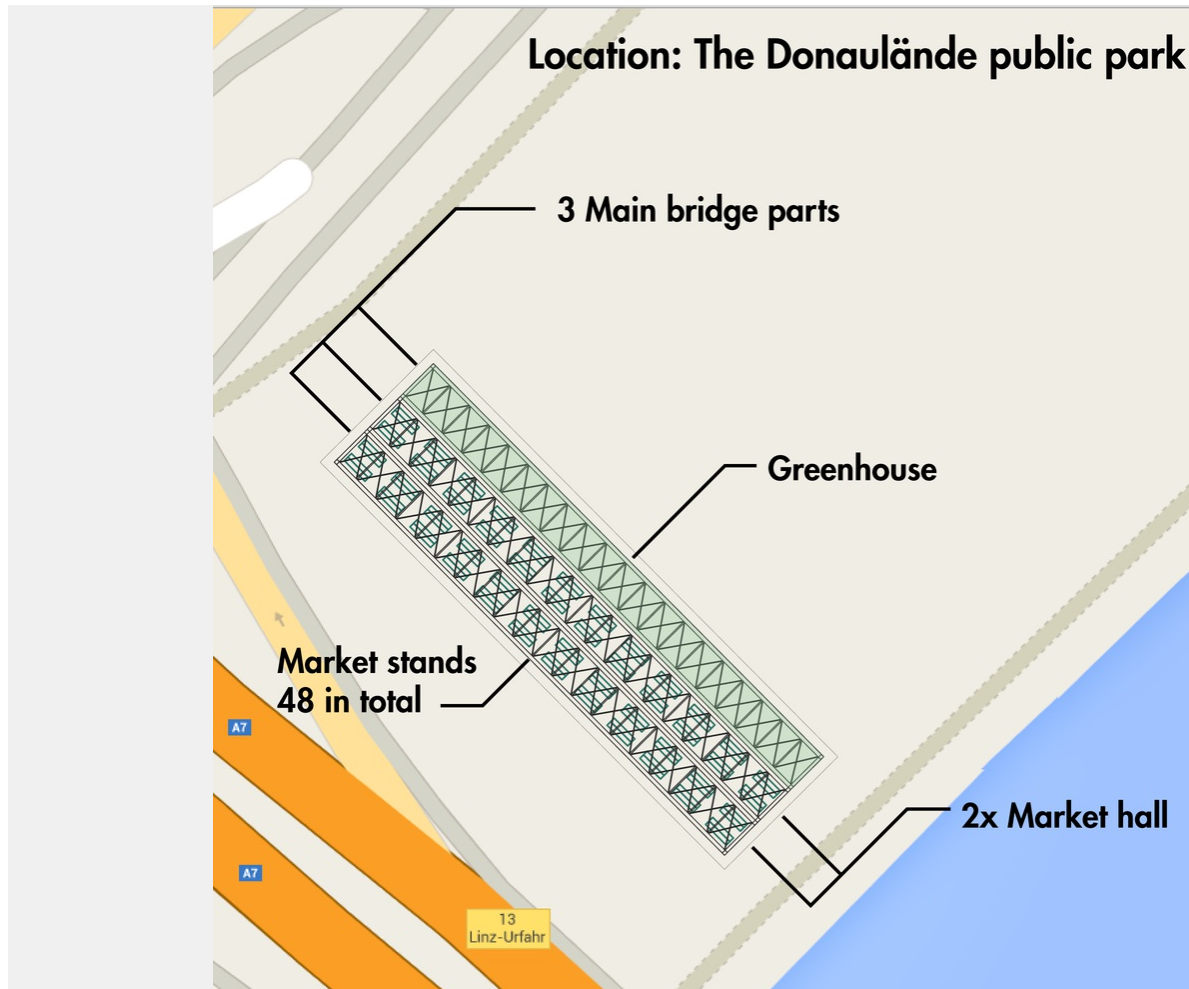


# 1/7 Eisenbahnmarkt

The bridge turned into a market with a greenhouse



## Solution

The 3 main bridge sections are placed next to each other, 2 parts will function as market halls and one part will be converted into a greenhouse using greenhouse foil. The Eisenbahnmarkt references indoor city markets as found in Barcelona and Linz's own Südbahnhof Markt. The entire sections are used without the need for extra structural support and the vendors can utilize the greenhouse to produce fresh products for the market without the need for transportation.
