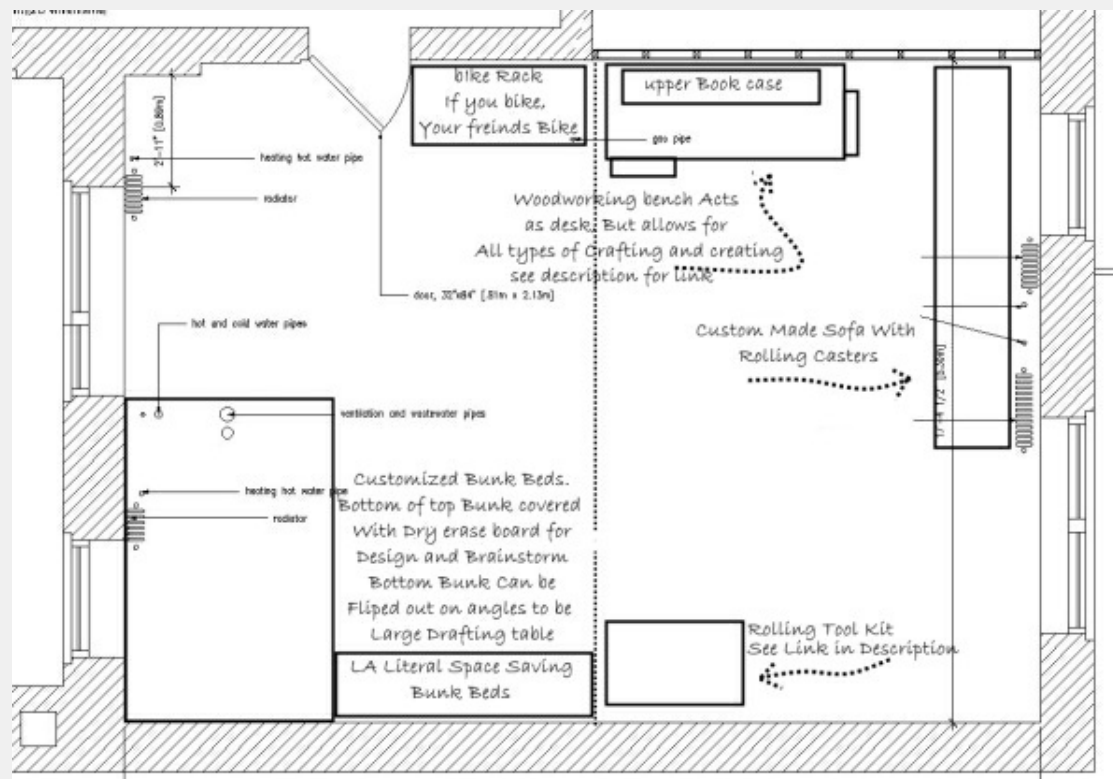


1/2 **A Floor you can eat off**

Open, but private, part apartment part workshop and home office.



Solution

It starts with a section of floor anchored to tracks that can be raised in four pieces to create a table and two benches. Mounted on the ceiling is a track that will allow dividers to separate the room into two sections. The same system is used in hotel convention spaces to divide large ballrooms into separate meeting spaces. The panels lock together with latches hidden inside them and need no ground support. The size of the panels allows them to turn into the pocket.

Because I like to create, and build things I would design the bathroom to double as a darkroom. Doesn't take much extra except the divided sink, a counter big enough to hold the enlarger. Several Easy to set up lines could be used for drying pictures and air drying clothes.
